

# RT Texas Summer SAT Intensive — Parent Information

---

Dear Parent,

We're opening enrollment for the **RT Texas Summer SAT Intensive 2026** — an 8-week personalized program designed for the August 22 Digital SAT test date.

---

## Why this program is different

---

Most SAT prep treats every student the same. Our program does the opposite. On Week 0 your student takes an adaptive diagnostic that identifies their weakest of 140 SAT Rules — then the platform builds a personal 8-week plan that targets exactly those weaknesses. No two students drill the same problems.

In class, students practice on their own device while the instructor watches a real-time dashboard showing the cohort's top weaknesses. Each session's 25-minute lecture covers exactly what the class is struggling with — not a generic textbook chapter.

By the end of Week 8, every student has taken 4 full Digital SATs scored against the College Board's official scoring table, and walks home with a personalized 6-page Final Review Packet for the two-week stretch before test day.

## The plan at a glance

<b>Target test</b>	Digital SAT — Saturday, August 22, 2026
<b>Program dates</b>	June 15 – August 7, 2026 (8 weeks)
<b>Diagnostic at home</b>	June 8 – 14 (about 20 minutes)
<b>Schedule</b>	3 days a week, 2 hours per session
<b>Class structure</b>	Mon — Math · Wed — Reading & Writing · Fri — Mock exam or mixed review
<b>Instructors</b>	Subject specialists (separate Math and R&W instructors)
<b>Class size</b>	Small group (up to 20 students per instructor)
<b>Homework</b>	About 30 minutes of cheatsheet reading or audio lessons on off-days. No active drilling at home — all problem-solving happens in class under instructor supervision.
<b>Mock exams</b>	4 full Digital SATs (July 10, July 24, July 31, August 7)
<b>Tuition</b>	[RT Texas to fill — recommended \$2,500 – \$3,500 per student]

## What you receive as a parent

---

- **Week 0 report** — your student's starting score, top 5 weaknesses, recommended target
  - **Bi-weekly progress reports** — score trend, attendance, mastery heatmap
  - **Two parent conferences** — Week 4 (mid-program) and Week 8 (final results)
  - **Mock score alerts** — within 24 hours of each mock, with your student's top 3 weaknesses
  - **Final report** — diagnostic-to-final comparison + readiness recommendation for August 22

## Why we end August 7 (two weeks before the test)

---

Two weeks of self-review with the Final Packet is essential. New material in the final 10 days hurts test-day performance; reviewing known weaknesses helps. Research consistently shows late-stage cramming is the #1 driver of test-day anxiety. Our schedule ends two weeks before the test by design — so your student has time to rest, review, and walk into Saturday August 22 prepared, not exhausted.

**Deadline: June 1, 2026** (one week before the at-home diagnostic begins).
